Supriya Roy has worked in Rabindra-Bhavana, the Tagore Memorial Museum, Archives and Research Centre of Visva-Bharati as Librarian and Archivist for three decades. The Content Writer in the Multimedia Project on Tagore, her publications include, *Rabindra-Bhavana Uttarayana: an Introduction, Tagoreana in the Modern Review*, and *Makers of a Mission*. She has edited *The English Writings of Rabindranath Tagore in the Visva-Bharati Quarterly, Vol. 1: Poems.* In her book, *Talks in Japan* she has collected and edited the talks given by Tagore in Japan. As series editor of the *Tagore Travelogues* for Visva-Bharati she has edited *Journey to Persia and Iraq, 1932,Letters from a Sojourner in Europe* and *Letters from Java: Rabindranath Tagore's Tour of Southeast Asia.* 

She edited the *Visva-Bharati News* and the *Rabindra-Bhavana*newsletter for a number of years. She prepared the Permanent Photograph Gallery on the life of Rabindranath for the Rabindranath Tagore Institute in Mauritius. She has curated an exhibition for ICCR, *Rabindranath Tagore and the Romance of Travel* in 2009. This year she curated another exhibition for ICCR, *Rabindranath Tagore: Pilgrimages to the East.*
